

CAUTION

For Household Use Only:
 Shake well before use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, earwigs, silverfish, sowbugs, silverfish, spiders, and centipedes. Spray thoroughly into hiding places, such as cracks, crevices, under baseboards, under refrigerator, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray trails, nest and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL GRAIN BEETLES—(CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLE)—(SAWTOOTH GRAIN BEETLE)—(LESSER GRAIN BORER): Remove infested grain, cereal, or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and foodstuffs in the area by removing before spraying. Spray directly on exposed stages and into cracks and crevices where grain beetles may be hiding. Repeat as necessary.

ANIMAL PEST—TO KILL FLEAS ON DOGS, CATS: Apply directly to animal's back, under forelegs, and on other areas except genitals and anus. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle

OUTDOORS—TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS: Kill aphids, exposed thrips, leafhoppers, two-spotted mites, plant bugs, Japanese beetles on smaller, tender garden plants, roses, hibiscus, red dogwood, palm nippers, ivy, viburnum, euonymus, oaks, maples, locust, forsythia and allinea. Kills mimosas, webworm larvae on mimosa. Spray directly on insects.

TO KILL APHIDS, EXPOSED THIRPS, ADULT WHITEFLIES, LEAFHOPPERS, TWO-SPOTTED MITES, PLANT BUGS, SPITTLEBUGS AND JAPANESE BEETLES: on peonies, lilies, zinnias, snapdragons, geraniums, chrysanthemums, nasturtiums, dahlias, geraniums, marigolds, daphne, fuchsia, ivy, tobacco, queen cactus, broadleaf acacia.

Hold container 18 inches from the infested plants. Spray in short bursts of one to three seconds, or spray at the rate of one linear foot of growth per second. Direct spray to all sides covering foliage on both sides. Repeat as necessary. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat if necessary to obtain control.

USE WITH CAUTION: on roses, junipers, roses, including hybrid tea roses, flowering quince, ash and camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under certain conditions of use. For adult whiteflies and two-spotted mites be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Use several repeat applications at two day intervals if necessary.
