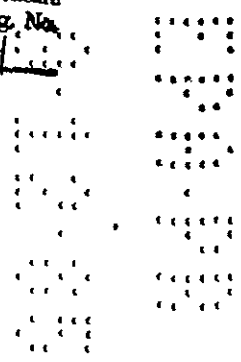

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

In the home do not spray food handling surfaces.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow humans or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If on skin or clothing: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician.

If inhaled: Remove to fresh air if effects occur and call a physician.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General: Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

For Spot Treatment: To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, and Sowbugs: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations.

Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick product before reentering area.

For Cracks and Crevices: To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Earwigs, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Carpet Beetles and Dermestids: Adjust sprayer to deliver a pin stream and apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Use in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above-listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.
