The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Revise your "Pesticide Disposal" statement as follows:

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acute hazardous. Improper disposal or discharge of excess pesticide cide or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions or cannot be discharged into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters in accordance with an NPDES permit, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

2. You may retain your "Statement of Practical Treatment" on your label at your option.
3. Follow type size requirements for all label elements.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipping.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

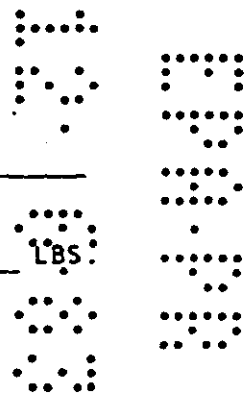

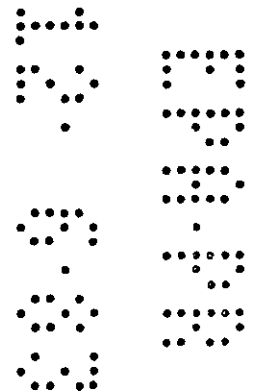
HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)

CAUTION: Keep away from humans, domestic animals and pets. Exposure during pregnancy should be avoided. If swallowed, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. When mixing baits, wear dust respirator and rubber gloves. If on skin, wash with soap and water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: If ingested, administer Vitamin K<sub>1</sub> intramuscularly or orally, as indicated in bishydroxycoumarin overdoses. Repeat as necessary based on monitoring of prothrombin times.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spills, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Sweep onto a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below.
