PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

STORAGE: If container is damaged: STOP any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand, or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour, or spill near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. Subject: Amendment - Update Label for Lindane D-3
Prentox 25% Lindane Watable Powder
EPA Registration No. 655-21
Application Dated November 14, 1983

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

- If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.
- If inhaled - Move victim to fresh air. Give artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

2. Please refer to the enclosed form also guide for assistance in selecting the correct print size for the front panel symbol void, child hazard warning, and the reading "Storage and Disposal."

3. In the Environmental Hazards text delete "Keep out of any body of water" and insert the following:

Do not discharge into lakes, ponds streams, or public waters unless in accordance with an N.P.D.E.S. permit. For guidance contact your regional office of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

4. Delete the heading "Directions for use continued" and relocate the two sentences to appear directly under the "It is a violation..." sentence.
5. Revise the directions for use to read "This product is to be used only for formulation of insecticides. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registrations for their formulated products."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until April 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.

It is noted that your cover letter mentions "This will be a restricted use pesticide." Lindane manufacturing products are not restricted use products.
