STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. We suggest revising the "If swallowed" advice to read "Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Contains petroleum distillates. Do Not Induce Vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia."
2. Change "May be harmful if swallowed..." to "Harmful if swallowed...."
3. Please refer to the enclosed type size guide for assistance in selecting the correct print size for the front panel signal word, child hazard warning, and the heading "Storage and Disposal."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label and the associated Product Information Sheet are enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until April 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
