Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame.

2. Change "Do not breathe vapors" to "Do not breath vapors or dust" in the Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals section.
3. Delete the heading "Directions for Use Continued" and the associated text at the bottom of the second page and instead add the following directly beneath the sentence "It is a violation of Federal law, etc.:"

This pesticide may be used only for the control of an insecticide. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products.

4. If there is a product description sheet, formulators should be referred to it in the above paragraph and five (5) copies should be forwarded to the Agency for acceptance to complete the product's labeling.
