At the next label printing, you must revise the declaration of percent active ingredient to 99.5% for both of these products, since they are repackagings of 99.5% lindane products. Please ensure that the associated bulletins (the "Product Information Sheets") are also revised to show the higher percentage. As indicated in the Lindane Registration Standard, the active ingredient should be declared as:

Lindane (gamma isomer of benzene hexachloride)

The common name and parentheses have been omitted on the current submissions.
