1. Please refer to the enclosed type size guide for assistance in selecting the correct print size for the front panel signal word, child hazard warning, and the heading "Storage and Disposal."
2. If the solvent declared on your formula statement of February 7, 1984, is Isco's solvent, list in the correct label solvent declaration table as Isco's solvent. Please do not list the enclosed term in label so that the registration will reflect current name of the solvent.
3. Change "This is a flammable liquid" to "This is a flammable liquid."
4. Your label refer for users to the label information sheet. Please submit a copy of this sheet with registration sheet to complete the registration file for this product.

Submit and (5) copies of your revised printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A hard copy of the label is enclosed to your records.

If you hold a Federal or State pesticide registration, or a special local insect registration, you may continue to produce and market such products, using current labeling, until April 1, 1985. After that
