WARFARIN IS AN ANTICOAGULANT CHEMICAL WHICH, IF INGESTED ACCIDENTALLY BY HUMAN BEINGS, DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR PETS, MAY REDUCE THE CLOTTING ABILITY OF THE BLOOD AND INTERNAL HEMORRHAGE MAY RESULT. IN CASE BAITS ARE ACCIDENTALLY SWALLOWED, GIVE A TABLESPOONFUL OF SALT IN A GLASS OF WARM WATER AND REPEAT UNTIL VOMIT FLUID IS CLEAR. CALL FOR A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

NOTE FOR PHYSICIANS:

WHEN A HUMAN HAS BEEN KNOWN TO HAVE ACCIDENTALLY INGESTED WARFARIN, BLOOD TRANSFUSIONS COMBINED WITH INTRAVENOUS INJECTIONS AND ORAL DOSES OF VITAMIN K ARE INDICATED AS IN THE CASE OF HEMORRHAGE CAUSED BY OVERDOSES OF DICUMAROL. (2)
