### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

Fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe dust. When mixing baits, use a dust/mist filtering respirator with MSHA/NIOSH approval prefix TC-19C. Wear protective clothing and waterproof gloves. Wash arms and face with soap and water after mixing or handling and before eating and smoking. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

Exposure to Warfarin during pregnancy should be avoided. Warfarin may cause harm to the fetus, including possible birth defects.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** If ingested, administer Vitamin K<sub>1</sub> intramuscularly or orally, as indicated in bishydroxycoumarin overdoses. Repeat as necessary, based on monitoring of prothrombin times. Severe cases may require administering Vitamin K<sub>1</sub> intravenously and giving blood transfusions.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Only for formulation into a Rodenticide for (1) The following uses: control of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice in and around homes, industrial buildings, and similar man-made structures and in transport vehicles; (2) Uses for which USEPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and (3) Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with USEPA requirements.

Formulators are responsible for providing data to support their registration.

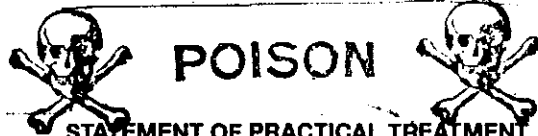

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In all cases of suspected poisoning, immediately contact a physician or Poison Control Center.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Drink 1 or 2 glasses of warm water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF ON SKIN:** Wash with plenty of soap and water.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water.

**IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Do not breathe dust. If breathing has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately and continue until physician sees victim.
