

**NOTE TO FORMULATORS**

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**If swallowed** — Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE vomiting unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If inhaled** — Move victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated. Call a physician immediately.

**If on skin** — Remove contaminated clothing and wash immediately with soap and water. Call a physician immediately if symptoms of poisoning occur.

**If in eyes** — Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

**Note to Physician**

**Symptoms:** Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin-point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps.

**Treatment:** Atropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation, atropine should be injected at ten-minute intervals, in doses of 1 to 2 milligrams, until complete atropinization has occurred. Morphine is contraindicated. Clear chest by postural drainage. Oxygen administration may be necessary. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. Observe patient continuously for 48 hours. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may, without warning, cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until cholinesterase regeneration has been attained as determined by blood test.

**Instructions for Formulation**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This pesticide may be used only for the formulation of an insecticide. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products. Refer to Technical Bulletin for instructions for formulating and other information.

**PROHIBITIONS**
