**ANTIDOTE:**

If swallowed, give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep warm and quiet. Call a Physician immediately. In case of skin contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash with soap and water. In case of eye contact, flush immediately with running water for at least 10 minutes and get medical attention.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal, and may be administered in conjunction with Atropine.
