



STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed — Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

If inhaled — Remove person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin — Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes — Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician — Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-Pam is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL


