**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**STORAGE:** If container is damaged, stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. 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

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**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (cont'd.)**

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or waste is a violation of Federal law. **DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Cont'd.)**

Area mosquito applications to populated and rural areas are to be made only by mosquito abatement districts, public health officers, public mosquito control officials, and commercial pest control operators. Helicopter applications made or supervised by a pest control operator must be made only under the qualified authority. Consult your state fish and game agency before applying this product.

**Fogging:** Read the entire label before using the product. For thermal fog application use this product undiluted in standard fogging machines which are calibrated to deliver 40 gallons per hour at a machine speed of 5 miles per hour to cover a swath width up to 350 feet. Repeat as necessary. **Airplane Application:** Apply undiluted at 3 quarts per acre for larva control, 6 quarts per acre for adult control. Allow at least three weeks between applications. **Larva Control:** Apply 3 quarts per acre undiluted or in sufficient oil (1 part product/1 part oil or a total volume of 1 1/4 gallons of diluted spray per acre) to obtain uniform coverage as a light spray. Allow at least 3 weeks between applications. Use only in intermittently flooded areas, standing water, temporary rain pools, sloughs, and log ponds.

\*Kerosene-type oil, fuel oil, diesel oil or other base oils suitable for insecticides.

**MIXING:** To mix with oil pour the required amount of this product into full amount of oil and then agitate.

**OTHER USE RESTRICTIONS:** Do not allow spray treatment or drift on pastureland, cropland, poultry ranges, or water supplies. Do not use inside homes, in dairy barns, poultry houses or in buildings where food is processed. Do not apply directly to animals. Do not use on crops used for food, forage or pasture.
