STORAGE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. - 2. Revise the If In Eyes section of your Statement Of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

- 3. Revise your Environmental Hazards paragraph to read as follows:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public water except in accordance with an NPDES permit. For further guidance, contact the nearest EPA Regional Office.
