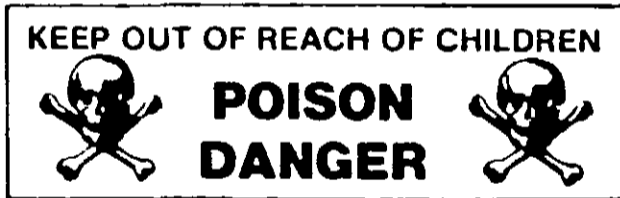

DANGER Poisonous if swallowed. Irritant to eyes. May be fatal if swallowed and breathed. Hazardous if inhaled. Wear natural rubber gloves, waterproof protective clothing and goggles when handling. Instructions for Formulation

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This pesticide may be used only for the formulation of an insecticide. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products. Refer to Technical Bulletin for instructions for formulating and other information.

Note to Physician

Symptoms: Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps.

Treatment: Atropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation, atropine should be injected at ten minute intervals in doses of 1 to 2 milligrams, until complete atropinization has occurred. Morphine is contraindicated. Clear chest by postural drainage. Oxygen administration may be necessary. 2-PAM is an antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. Observe patient continuously for 48 hours. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may, without warning, cause ptosis, diplopia, and other signs of cholinesterase inhibition. Avoid further exposure until cholinesterase regains normal activity, as determined by blood test.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed — If a patient has swallowed this concentrate, induce vomiting if the patient was taken orally. Do not feed. Do not give any food or drink until treatment is completed. Vomiting may be induced by the administration of the necessary fluid, including water, in two or three small quantities. Do not force the back of the tongue into the mouth to induce vomiting. Do not induce vomiting if the patient is unconscious.

If inhaled — Move victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated. Call a physician immediately.

If on skin — Remove contaminated clothing and wash immediately with soap and water. Call a physician immediately.

If in eyes — Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

This concentrate is formulated for use in the formulation of insecticides. It is not to be used as a stand-alone product.
