DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: STOP any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Before using this compound, exposed food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or protected. Application continued to time periods when plant is not in operation. **CONTACT SPRAY:** Dilute with Deionized Kerosene on a 1 to 6 basis to be used as a surface spray for control of roaches, waterbugs and silverfish in the edible products areas of Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Processing Plants. For control of roaches, waterbugs and silverfish thorough and repeated spraying of the infested area, working the spray into cracks and other hiding places is recommended. Emphasis should be placed on hitting the insects directly and on repeated applications. Direct the spray to insect hiding places.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOGGING

Close windows and doors and shut off ventilating system. Use a fogger or vaporizer adjusted to deliver an aerosol spray (no droplets over 50 microns in diameter and 80% less than 30 microns). Apply at the rate of 1 oz. per 1000 cu. ft. of space. Direct the spray toward the ceiling and upper corners of area and behind obstructions. Keep area closed for at least 15 minutes. Vacate treated area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary. Contact spray treatment for crawling insects should be used in combination with the fogging treatment.

The above described application will kill accessible, exposed stages of flies, fruit flies, mosquitoes, silverfish, flying moths, gnats, crickets, roaches, spiders, scorpions, wasps, hornet clover mites, cheese mites, cheese skippers and these common stored product pests, granary weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, spider beetles, cigarette beetles, Drugstore beetles, Angoumois grain moths, Mediterranean flour moths, Indian meal moths, tobacco moths, meal worms and grain mites.
