The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Delete the proposed heading and text "Directions for use continued" and insert the following directly under "It is a violation...":

This pesticide may only be used for formulation of an insecticide. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products.

2. Please refer to the enclosed type size guide for assistance in selecting the correct print size for the front panel signal word, child hazard warning, and the heading "Storage and Disposal."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until April 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventory of such products will fall under the existing "stock provisions" set forth in our letter of October 20, 1983.
