 - a. In the Environmental Hazards, replace the second sentence with:
"Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters, unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge."

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- b. In the DIRECTIONS FOR USE, delete items "(2)" and "(3)" and their associated text. Also, delete the remaining number "(1)", since there will only be one entry.
 - c. In the STORAGE section delete the mark after "damaged" and the crossed out capital "S" before "stop".
3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
