**REGISTRATION:** EPA Reg. #655-396

**DESCRIPTION:** An Oil Concentrate containing Diazinon, Pyrethrins and Dual Synergists (Piperonyl Butoxide & MGK-264), designed for the formulation of Pressurized Sprays. It must first be diluted 5 lbs. of Concentrate with 95 lbs. of Deodorized Kerosene. Then, mix 70 lbs. of diluted Concentrate with 30 lbs. of Propellant. This yields 1/2% Diazinon and dual Synergized Pyrethrins.

**CONTROLS:** When diluted as indicated, a broad spectrum Insecticide for control of roaches, ants, waterbugs, silverfish, etc. See suggested John Doe label for details.
