Your Submissions Dated April 18, 1983, and July 18, 1984

The label amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA Section 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Based upon the statements of formula submitted April 18, 1983, under the Diazinon date call-in as well as that accompanying your July 18, 1984, submission, the correct percent of petroleum distillate to be declared is 74.48% with 2.15% declared inert ingredients. The label ingredients statement should be revised accordingly.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The updated formula statement is acceptable and has been added to the product's registration file. It is noted that your April 18, 1983, formula statement showed a batch weight of 1000 lbs, while that submitted July 18, 1984, presumably adds up to 100 lbs, but a value was not entered in block 17.
