STORAGE

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Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE - If container is damaged. Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear.
