STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
Open dumping prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: STOP any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required as prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use pour or spill near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Dilute 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ by volume with Deodorized Kerosene (18 $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. to make 1 gallon finished spray).

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, ANTS, BEDBUGS, SILVERFISH: Use 3 to 4 ounces for each 1,000 cu. ft. of space, directing the spray to contact as many insects as possible. Pay particular attention to baseboards, wall mouldings, woodwork and pipe openings, breeding places and nests.

MOTHS: Use 1 to 2 ounces per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. When spraying clothes in storage for adult moths, separate clothing, for the larvae paying particular attention to seams and folds of garments. Clothing should be

sprayed individually. For storing clothing in chests - first treat as per above, and also spray storage container before packing. Repeated monthly applications are advisable.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Use $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. per 1,000 cu. ft. of space, directing spray toward ceiling.

BEDBUGS: Use 1 to 2 oz. per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Spray mouldings, baseboards and cracks. Also spray the bedstead paying particular attention to cracks and crevices, spray springs and mattresses as well.

FOR INSECTS AFFECTING STORED FOOD, FLOUR, GRAIN AND CEREALS-DO NOT SPRAY DIRECTLY ON EXPOSED FOOD, FLOUR, GRAIN OR CEREALS: Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

To kill the exposed stages of Indian meal moth, Angoumois grain moth, chocolate moth, carpet beetle, cigarette beetle, flat grain beetle, confused flour beetle, saw-toothed grain beetle, rice weevils, cadelles, use 3 to 4 ounces per 1,000 cu. ft. of space directing the spray so as to contact the insects. Pay particular attention to cracks, crevices and other hiding places. Repeat treatment as required.

KILLS INSECTS ONLY WHEN THE SPRAY CONTACTS THEM

Sanitation is necessary. Clean and remove deposits of food, grain and dust from storage areas. Clean conveyer and handling equipment.
