When spraying clothes separate clothing, for the attention to seams and if should be sprayed individually in chests -- first treat as storage containers before application is advised.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES: 1 ounce of space, directing

BEDBUGS: Use 1 to 2 oz. Spray mattress base and any the bedstead, pay cracks and crevices spray as well.

FOR INSECTS AFFECTING FLOUR, GRAIN AND OTHER DIRECTLY ON EXPOSED OR CEREALS: Proceeding during treatment. All should be covered during cleaned before using. In these areas, apply only in operation.

To kill the exposed stages. Angoumois grain moth, beetle, cigarette beetle, flour beetle, saw-toothed caddis, use 3 to 4 ounce directing spray so as to particular attention to hiding places.
