

**Precautionary Statements**  
**Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals**  
**WARNING**

May be fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Causes substantial, but temporary eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Keep out of reach of domestic animals. Do not use on humans, pets or livestock. Do not contaminate ornamental fish ponds. Do not permit children or pets to go onto sprayed grass until spray has completely dried. For foliar application to agricultural crops whose culture involves hand labor, there is a 24-hour re-entry period (See Re-entry statement).

Food utensils such as measuring spoons should not be used for food purposes after use in measuring pesticides. Be sure to read and follow the "Work Safety Rules" that appear in this booklet.

**Statement of Practical Treatment**

**If swallowed, call a physician immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING UNLESS NO OTHER TREATMENT IS AVAILABLE.** Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing.

**If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated.**

**If on skin, wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.**

**If in eyes, rinse eyes with plenty of water and call a physician immediately.**

**Note to Physician:** This product is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. This product contains a xylene range aromatic solvent which may present an aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage may be indicated if product was taken internally.

**Environmental Hazards**

This product is highly toxic to birds, fish and other wildlife. Birds, especially waterfowl, feeding or drinking on treated areas may be killed. Because of the migratory habits of Atlantic Coast waterfowl, do not apply this product to lawns in Nassau County, New York between November 1 and May 20. Do not exceed maximum permitted label rates. Rates above those recommended significantly increase potential hazards to birds and waterfowl. Avoid overlapping of sprays. If waterfowl, i.e., ducks or geese, can be expected in the treated area after spraying this product, however stop watering before puddling occurs. ~~Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes).~~ Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Do not apply where fish, shrimp, crab, and other aquatic life are important resources.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of equipment wash waters. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this pesticide or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

**Physical or Chemical Hazards**

Do not use, pour, spill, or store near heat or open flame.

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For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark.
