PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not use on plants. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs or water supplies. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
Open dumping prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: STOP any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Do not store, use pour or spill near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Mix 1 part PRENTOX PB CONCENTRATE #20 with 19 parts Deodorized Kerosene (7.4 oz. to make 1 gallon of finished spray.)

FOOD SHOULD BE REMOVED OR COVERED DURING TREATMENT. ALL FOOD PROCESSING SURFACES SHOULD BE COVERED DURING TREATMENT OR THOROUGHLY CLEANED BEFORE USING. WHEN USING THE PRODUCT IN THESE AREAS, APPLY ONLY WHEN THE FACILITY IS NOT IN OPERATION.

1. TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS: Close doors and windows directing the spray toward the ceiling. The room should be filled with mist and remain closed for 10-20 minutes. Sweep up dead or stupefied insects and destroy them. Repeat treatment as often as necessary. The frequent spraying of breeding places, such as stagnant water, manure piles also help.

2. TO KILL SILVERFISH: Spray liberally with force around refrigerators, sinks, cabinets, around pantry shelves, into all cracks and crevices, in moulding and woodwork, pipe openings in walls and floors or wherever these insects are likely to hide. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.

3. TO KILL ANTS: Use the spray so as to wet as many of the insects as possible, paying particular attention to nests and runways. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.

4. TO KILL BEDBUGS: Bedsteads should be sprayed thoroughly in all corners, cracks and crevices. Springs and mattresses should be sprayed thoroughly after the bed has been dismantled, paying particular attention to cracks, crevices, tufts and seams on mattresses, wallpaper that is loose, loose moulding and any place where these bugs may hide. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.

5. TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES: Take special precautions to see that cracks in floors and openings below baseboards are thoroughly wetted with spray liquid. Wool lint and organic matter accumulating in these places will serve as breeding materials for such pests. Clothing to be stored should be cleaned and aired and sprayed carefully at a distance of one to two feet taking care to see that seams and folds are wetted. Chests in which woolens are to be stored should be thoroughly sprayed before being filled with clothes. Closets should be sprayed liberally at least twice a month, directing the spray on the garments.

6. TO KILL FLEAS: Liberally spray all infested places-rugs and under rugs, basements, under porches, and wherever pet animals make their bed. Spray bedding of household pets. Do not spray directly on animals. Repeat as required.
