**DIRECTIONS FOR USE - Household Insects**

To Control Household Insects:\*\* Dilute Diazinon 4S with deodorized kerosene or other suitable base oil to make a 1/2% or 1% Diazinon spray and apply as indicated below. Repeat application as necessary.

**Spray Dilution Chart**

**Cockroaches (Waterbugs), Ants, and Silverfish:**

Make spot applications of 1/2% Diazinon as a coarse spray or apply with a paint brush to baseboards, areas around water pipes, cracks and crevices, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and similar areas where these insects hide.

For heavy cockroach infestation, make the first application at a strength of 1% Diazinon, followed by monthly applications of 1/2% Diazinon.

**Carpet Beetles:**

Apply a 1/2% Diazinon spray in spot applications along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting and rugs and furniture, closets, and shelving, and wherever these insects are known to frequent.

**Spiders and Scorpions:**

Apply a 1/2% Diazinon spray around and under doors and windows. Make spot applications in other areas over which the insect may travel.

**Pantry Pests - exposed stages (Saw-toothed Grain Beetle, Flour Beetle, Rice Weevil, Cigarette Beetle, Drugstore Beetle, Indian-meal Moth):**

Apply a 1/2% Diazinon spray to the surfaces of food handling equipment, premises, and utensils. Do not apply to any surface which will come in contact with food, feed, or animal feed. Do not apply to any surface which will be used for food, feed, or animal feed.

**Brown Dog Ticks in Buildings**

Make thorough applications of 1/2% Diazinon spray to the bed areas, behind baseboards, window and door frames, walls, and other areas frequented by household pets, and the exteriors of floors and the surrounding areas. Fresh bedding should be placed in and around the dog's sleeping quarters. Do not treat animals with this formulation.
