STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- IF SWALLOWED - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- IF INHALED - Remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- IF ON SKIN - Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.
- IF IN EYES - Rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

If signs of cholinesterase inhibition are present. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM may be administered in conjunction with a trypine.
