#### Statement of Practical Treatment

Howed - Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE vomiting unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person

It inhaled — Remove victim to tresh air Apply respiration if indicated It on skin — Wash immediately with soap and water

H in eyes - Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water Call a physician immediately

IF WARNING SYMPTOMS APPEAR: Administer two 1/100-grain Atropine tablets immediately NEVER ADMINISTER ATROPINE UNLESS WARNING SYMPTOMS APPEAR (See WARNING SYMPTOMS below) Keep patient prone and quiet. Start artificial respiration immediately, if patient is not breathing. Transport the patient

immediately to the nearest 7h sician. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN - WARNING SYMPTOMS: Symptoms include weakness, headache, lightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin-point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal cramps. TREATMENT: Alropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation

If there are signs of parasympathet - stimulation. Atropine Sultate should be injected at 10-minute in ervals. In doses of to 2 milligrams until complete Atropinization has occurred. Morphine is contraindicated: 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with Atropine. Clear chest by postural drainage.

Repealed exposure to choinesterase inhibitors may without warring, cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor.

Allow no further exposure until time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by blood test



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#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE - TO BE APPLIED BY PEST CONTROL OPERATORS OR TRAINED PERSONNEL ONLY-

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INDOOR PEST CONTROL-Apply VAPON Insecticide as a 0.5% spray to control flies, mosquitoes, wasps, gnats, flying moths, and other small flying insects, cockroaches, ants, spiders, silverlish. To prepare a 0.5% spray, dilute 1 pint of VAPON 2 Emul. Conc. with 6 gallons of water.

For Households, Restaurants, Theaters, Food Processing Plants, Industrial Plants, Warehouses, apply 0.5% spray with low pressure sprayer to localized areas insects may infest. Treat infested areas around baseboards, cracks, walls, door and window frames, and localized areas of floors. Do not apply to areas which will be contacted frequently by children and do not allow them in treated areas until surfaces are dry. Do not contaminate food, water, food containers, or cooking utensils. Do not treat animals.

Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, INDUSTRIAL PLANTS, THEATERS, WAREHOUSES-FOR THE CONTROL OF FLIES, ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH-

Apply with fogging or misting equipment at the rate of 1 gallon of 1% fogging solution per 64,000 cubic feet, for control of flies. When fogging for control of roaches, ants and silverfish, the fog should be directed into cracks and crevices and hiding places. Apply when plants are not in operation. Occupants should vacate before indoor treatments and should not reoccupy the premises until they have been ventilated. After application, open several windows or doors, to create air currents to insure reduction of VAPON Insecticide vapors. Food should be removed and food handling equipment covered with

wrapping paper during application, or washed after application is completed. WHEN FOGGING OR SPRAY MISTING-

Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part II.

## OUTDOOR AREAS - CONTROL OF FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS-

Apply with fogging apparatus or mist blowers at the rate of 5-10 pints of 1% fogging solution per acre (equivalent to 0.05-0.1 pound VAPON Insecticide per acre.) Do not treat areas where food or feed crops are growing.

#### Outdoor living areas, picnic grounds, backyard area, patios, loading docks, outdoor latrines, parking area, refuse areas around service stations, open-air drive-ins, ice cream stands, garbage collection and disposal areas.

Apply VAPON 2 Insecticide as a 0.5% spray to control flies, gnats, mosquitoes, roaches, fleas, ants, sowbugs and brown dog ticks.

To prepare a 0.5% spray, dilute 1 pint of VAPON 2 Emulsifiable Concentrate with 6 gallons of water. Apply as a coarse wet spray at the rate of 1 quart per 1,000 sq. ft. Do not treat animals or humans. Do not contaminate water. food, food containers or cooking utensils. Repeat as necessary.

Apply VAPON 2 Insecticide as a 1% to 3% log or mist solution to control flies, mosquitoes, wasps, gnats, and other small flying insects in outdoor areas.


To prepare a 1% fogging or misting solution, dilute 1 quart of VAPON 2 Emulsifiable Concentrate with 6 gallons of water. For a 1% solution, rilute 1 quart with 7 gallons of oil.

#### MANURE PILES, GARBAGE DUMPS-

For the control of Hy maggots in maggot breeding areas apply at the rate of 1-2 quarts of 0.5% spray per 100 Eq. ft. (1 quart of 1%).

#### DOG KENNELS-

Apply to outside dog runways, window sills and ledges at a rate of 1 quart of 0.5% spray per 1,000 sq. ft. For the control of fless and brown dog ticks, increase dosage to 2 quarts of 0.5% spray per 1,000 sq. ft.


