DIRECTIONS: Dilute at rate of 1 gal. Concentrate with 4 gal. of water. Add some water to the sprayer tank first, then add PRENTOX PYRONYL 1.2-2.4-4.0 E.C. and stir. Make up to volume with water and agitate vigorously until a complete emulsion is obtained. The resulting water emulsion should be used fresh the same day and should not be allowed to stand overnight or longer. Spray the emulsion on grain storage bins, elevator booths, mill walls, and floors, etc., paying special attention to cracks, crevices and other insect hiding places. Do not spray on foodstuffs. Use the diluted spray at intervals of 1 to 2 weeks, or as needed. Alkaline surfaces such as cement, mortar, or calcimined wood or metal require more frequent applications than neutral surfaces.
