Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not use on plants. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils contaminated with this product. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not apply directly to milk. In barns and poultry houses, warehouses, etc., cover or remove any food or food processing equipment during application. After space spraying in these areas, wash thoroughly with an acceptable detergent solution and then rinse with potable water to remove all traces of contamination. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment and thoroughly cleaned before use.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
For best results, use a good clean sprayer, free of rust, which produces a fine mist.

FOR FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, gnats & wasps: Close door and windows. Spray freely towards ceiling in all directions until room is fogged with mist. When spraying, keep about three feet from interior walls, fabrics and furniture. Doors and windows may be opened after 10 minutes. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, waterbugs, silverfish & crickets: Spray thoroughly into cracks and crevices, under and behind sinks, cupboards, drawers, woodwork, refrigerators, pipes and drains, where these insects hide. Spray directly on as many insects as possible. Repeat application as necessary.

FOR CLOTHES MOTHS & CARPET BEETLES: Clean and spray closets thoroughly, to reach all hiding places. Clean and brush woolen articles. Repeat application every 30 days. When carpets are infested, spray both sides thoroughly. When spraying near fabrics, keep spray in constant motion, at least 36 inches away from fabric. Spraying closer may cause stains.

FOR BEDBUGS: Spray baseboards, molding and floor boards. Spray mattresses and box springs. It will be necessary to dismantle the bed completely, thoroughly spraying each part, including mattress and box springs. All baseboards and wall cracks about the bedroom, should be thoroughly treated. Repeat application and direct contact of the pest with spray are necessary for control.

FOR ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around window frames and openings around pipes and baseboards, where ants crawl, hitting as many as possible. Repeat application as necessary.

FOR FLEAS: Spray floors, floor coverings and sleeping quarters of pets and other infested areas. Repeat as required. Do not spray pets.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required as to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame. Do not store in car trunk where temperatures may exceed 120° F.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
