- On page 3, the reference to "resistant and non-resistant cockroaches" must be revised to read, "cockroaches."

**INDOORS:**

**To Kill Pests in and around stores and warehouses:** To kill ants (excluding carpenter, fire, harvester and pharaoh ants), cockroaches, millipedes, silverfish, spiders (excluding black widow and brown recluse spiders), waterbugs and saw-toothed grain beetles (exposed stages), apply as a coarse spray to cracks and crevices, along baseboards, to door and window sills, as well as inaccessible areas, behind stoves, refrigerators, around garbage cans, compactors and utility installations. **DO NOT spray open floor areas, carpets or furniture.** For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises.

**OUTDOORS:**

**To Kill insects around industrial buildings, garbage areas and dumps:** To kill ants (excluding carpenter, fire, harvester and pharaoh ants), brown dog ticks, clover mites, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, millipedes, sowbugs, spiders (excluding black widow and brown recluse) and waterbugs, apply as a spray to surfaces of buildings, porches, screens, window frames, patios and garages, where these insects congregate. Do not apply as a landscape treatment (to lawns, shrubs or trees, garden plants).

**To Kill hornets and wasps,** apply to nests under eaves or in ornamental plantings and retainer walls, as a coarse and/or pin stream spray only. Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Do not apply as a landscape treatment (to lawns, shrubs or trees, garden plants).

**FOR USE IN THE INEDIBLE PRODUCT AREAS OF MEAT PACKING AND FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS.**

Any exposed food products, equipment or packing materials must be removed or covered before spraying. Equipment and utensils in Federally inspected meat and poultry plants must be washed with an acceptable detergent solution and rinsed with potable water to remove all traces of contamination. Treat food processing plants early in the season before canning or other processing begins. Repeat applications, if necessary, when plant is not in operation. To kill ants (excluding carpenter, fire, harvester and pharaoh ants), cockroaches, millipedes, silverfish, spiders (excluding black widow and brown recluse), waterbugs and saw-toothed grain beetle (exposed stages).

**NON-FOOD AREAS:** Includes garbage rooms lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

**SPRAYING UNLOADING DOCKS AND OUTSIDE AREAS WHERE INSECTS** congregate will aid in preventing reinfestations. Good sanitation and proper disposal of wastes is essential in any effective insect control program.

**FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY** - Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** If container is damaged – Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame. Do not store in car trunk where temperatures may exceed 120°F.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**Container Disposal:** Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available.
