### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED** — Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.  
**IF INHALED** — Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.  
**IF ON SKIN** — Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.  
**IF IN EYES** — Rinse eyes with plenty of water and call a physician immediately.  
**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE: (Cont'd)

#### FOR CONTROL OF HYPERODES WEEVIL (New York only)

Apply 2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. of lawn. Water grass thoroughly after application. Treat problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May.

#### SPOT TREATMENT

**Ants:** Apply 1 1/2 teaspoons of Prentox Diazinon 5G in and around each individual ant hill.

**Digger wasps:** Apply 1 1/2 teaspoons of Prentox Diazinon 5G in and around each individual ground nest opening. Make the application about dusk when the wasps are not active.

#### BAND TREATMENT AROUND FOUNDATION

The following insects are commonly found around or near the foundation of houses as well as the lawn. Certain of these insects may even enter the house:

**ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS, SPRINGTAILS (COLLEMBOLA).**

For control of the above, apply a five-foot band of Prentox Diazinon 5G next to the foundation of the house. Distribute the granules uniformly using a rate of 3.2 oz. for each 5' by 20' area to be treated.

**NOTE:** The spreader settings listed below are approximate. Accurately weigh a few pounds into your spreader and apply to a measured area. Then adjust the spreader setting if necessary in order to assure correct rate of application.
