DIRECTIONS FOR FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS - (Place other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served)

FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK & CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY - Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation).

To control roaches, ants, earwigs, waterbugs, silverfish, spiders and crickets, apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, in conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application, de-energize electrical equipment. After application, allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or plating machines in "ON" position. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contaminating of food or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT IS NOT PERMITTED.

SERVING AREAS - Facilities where foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held, apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed).

DIRECTIONS FOR HOUSEHOLD AND OUTDOOR USE IN NON-FOOD AREAS - Including garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets, and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as required.

BROWN DOG TICKS - Apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas, such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with the product.

FLIES & MOSQUITOES - Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of windows and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, patios and in garages, where these insects may congregate. Flies & mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: STOP any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand, or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour, or spill near heat or open flame.
