STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE. If container is damaged, stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand, or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (cont'd)

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL. Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of consistently at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or purchase and dispose of in a similar manner, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Directions for use (cont.)

Fog picnic area or other localized areas where mosquitoes abide.

MOSQUITOES OUTDOORS. Make final fogging application for temporary control of small populations of pests in tall grass, shrubbery, and around lawns where these pests may be concentrated. Fog when an S.W. wind will not exceed five miles per hour and would require frequent re-application to kill additional insects that may be drifting into area.

Do not wet the foliage since many of the formulations are phytotoxic.

Do not fog when winds and/or fog are blowing. Do not fog when wind is blowing and fog will cover area to be treated. The fog should not be applied at a distance to shrubs or other plants.

Fogging is most effective if completed about two hours before area is to be used.

Application of this product to any body of water is prohibited.

Not for Electric or Power sprayers or other attachments.

Do not dilute with anything else. Always use Prentox in a clean fogger.
