PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

May be absorbed through skin. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid skin contact. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use on household pets and humans. Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS - This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Birds and other wildlife feeding in treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

BENEFICIAL INSECT CAUTION - This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on the treated area. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting the crop, cover crop, or weeds blooming in the treatment area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
Open dumping prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand, or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame. Do not store in car trunk where temperatures may exceed 120°F.

One Quart Makes 182 Gallons of Water Type Insecticide Treatment for Spraying Beef Cattle

FOR BACK RUBBING UNITS Use a 2% Lindane Oil Solution. Prepare by mixing 1 quart of 20% LINDANE EMULSIFIABLE with 27 1/2 gallons of #2 fuel oil. Then treat the burlap wrapped cable with this mixture. One gallon of this mixture will treat 10 to 20 lineal feet of burlap sacks. Retreat your burlap every 3 to 4 weeks. Do not make back rubber accessible to beef cattle within 30 days of slaughter. Animals under 6 months of age should not be allowed access to the back rubber treatment.

FOR SPRAY Mix 1 quart 20% LINDANE EMULSIFIABLE in 182 gallons of water applying 2 1/2 gallons of spray per adult animal using a sprayer giving about 400# pressure. Complete coverage is essential for good control. Keep direct spray out of animals' eyes. Limit spray applications to a 0.030 Lindane to young animals over 3 months of age. Caution: Do not treat animals in cold, stormy weather and avoid treating overheated or sick animals. Do not spray animals within 30 days of slaughter. Two applications, a week to 10 days apart, are required. Repeat as often as necessary.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- The RPAP Notice incorrectly indicated the language to be used for the RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE statement. Delete "For application only by or under the direct supervision of a certified applicator" and insert the following at the top of the front panel above the product name. (Note: type size requirements for the heading "RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE" are the same as required for the front panel signal word.)

RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE

For retail sale to and use only by Certified Applicators or persons under their direct supervision, and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator's certification.

- The "If swallowed" section of PRACTICAL TREATMENT is inadequate, please use the following:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material is still in the stomach. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

- Put the following at the top of the front panel:

suit or coveralls, unlined waterproof gloves (natural rubber, neoprene, polyethylene), and unlined, lightweight boots.

Mixer/loaders must wear goggles or face shield, waterproof apron, and waterproof gloves.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until April 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 20, 1983.
