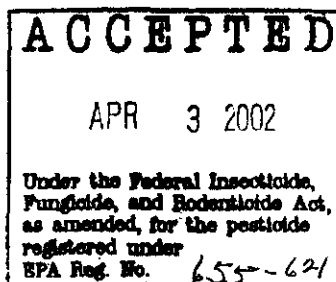

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Cover or remove fish bowls before use. All food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before reuse.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
Shake before using. Point valve opening away from face and push button, holding container as upright as possible.

HOME PESTS

FOR FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, flying moths, gnats, wasps. Close doors and windows and spray up into the air with a sweeping motion, directing mists to all parts of the room. Keep about three feet from walls, furniture, and fabrics. Keep room closed for 15 minutes, then air before occupancy.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, ants, fleas, waterbugs, crickets, silverfish, centipedes, spiders, sowbugs, bedbugs, earwigs, carpet beetles. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, under sink, around baseboard, in cupboards. Spray trails, next and points of entry. Hit as many bugs as possible. Spray top and undersides of rugs to kill carpet beetles. For bedbugs, remove bedding and spray mattress, seams, and folds.

GARDEN PESTS

Asters, azaleas, dahlias, marigolds, delphiniums, roses, iris, salvia, gladiola, begonias, petunias, snapdragons, chrysanthemums, African violets, English ivy, sansevieria, evergreens, and deciduous shrubs. To control aphids, red spiders, exposed thrips, leafhoppers, Japanese beetles, climbing cutworms, certain caterpillars, hold container 18 inches away from plant and spray with a sweeping motion spraying in short bursts. Avoid wetting foliage, a light spray kills pests effectively. Spray directly on insects, covering foliage thoroughly. Use with caution on tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray in direct sunlight or to wet plants. For mealybugs and whitefly larvae use frequently, and spray lightly but thoroughly.

PRE-TREATMENT DIRECTIONS

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE

USE ONLY ON DOGS TO KILL FLEAS AND LICE: Do not use on animals under 12 weeks.

SPECIAL ANIMALS

Consult a veterinarian or call the National Pesticide Telecommunications Network at 1-800-858-7378 before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, nursing, or medicated animals.

ADVERSE REACTION INFORMATION

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately, or call the National Pesticide Telecommunications Network at 1-800-858-7378.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

DOGS: To kill fleas and lice apply directly to animals along back, under forelegs, and other infested areas. Part the hair to contact skin, holding nozzle 12 inches away. Avoid spraying into eyes, mouth and ears of animal. Be sure to also thoroughly spray sleeping quarters of infested animals.

REAPPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Do not reapply for 7 days.

CAUTION: Do not apply to humans, birds or pets, other than dogs. Avoid prolonged or repeated skin contact. Remove bird cages for one hour before spraying room. Cover exposed food before spraying. Can be used around food products provided they are protected from direct contact during spraying. Avoid inhalation. Store in a cool place (not over 120° F). Do not spray plastic, asphalt tile, or furniture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Contents under pressure, exposure to high temperatures may cause can to burst. Do not puncture or incinerate can. Keep at room temperature and away from direct sunlight.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep in locked storage area.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture. If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
