Also revise the "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN" as follows:

"Note to Physician: This solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in combination with atropine."
