### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

##### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Remove children and pets from treatment area and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not smoke while spraying. For use as spot treatment only. Do not use as a space spray.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Repeatedly takes streams, ponds. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on the treated area. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting weeds or other vegetation blooming in the treatment area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity.

#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**NOTE:** Do not apply as a space spray. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Spill dumping is prohibited.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide spray mixture or residue that can't be used or chemically processed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides, or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** 33 & 55 gallon drums: a) Reseal container and offer for reconditioning, or b) Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill, or bury in a safe place.

**SMALLER CONTAINERS:** As in b) above.

**CONSUMER PACKING:** 1 gallon or less. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**If swallowed** — Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING** unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If inhaled** — Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.

**If on Skin** — Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.

**If in Eyes** — Rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call physician immediately.

**Note to Physician:** If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with 2-PAM.

**ANTS:** For use indoors or outdoors. Application: Pour into sprayer. Spray infested surfaces only until wet.

**ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERTAILS, SPIDERS, FLEAS, CRICKETS, EARWIGS:** Spray until wet surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, trim, stoves, and other kitchen areas infested with insects. For treatment around window frames and door frames where ants enter. Repeat as necessary.

**FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS AND FLYING MOTHS - OUTDOORS:** For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors around window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

**CRAWLERS, ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CLOVER BITES AND FLEAS - OUTDOORS:** For treatment of localized infestations of insects in outdoor areas spray infested areas including spraying of weeds and brushy run crop areas around the home. For ants, wetness and runways. Repeat as necessary.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
