

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

NewsBowed — Call aphysician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE vomiting unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person

Minhaled — Move victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated. Calla physician immediately

M on skin — Remove contaminated clothing and wash immediately with soap and water. Call a physician immediately if symptoms of poisoning occur.

If in eyes — Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

PRECAUTIONS:

PRECAUTIONS:
The following safety precautions are recommended in the plant area where Diazinon insecticides are being manufactured.

1) In mixing areas, respirators should be worn. (See list of acceptable respirators).

2) Street clothing should not be worn in mixing areas during the handling of the material. Clothing contaminated with any chemical should be faundered before re-use. Those directly exposed to a mixing process should wear rubber gloves, waterproof protective clothing goggles and subbershoe covers.

3) A shower should be taken at the end of each day.

4) No food or smoking should be permitted in a mixing area.

5) Workmen should wash thoroughly before eating or smoking.

6) Maintenance workmen should maintain the same precautions and should wear the same type of clothing as those directly concerned with mixing.

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NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

SYMPTOMS: Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin-point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps.

Treatment: Alropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic stimulation, alropine should be injected atten-minute intervels indoses of 1 to 2 milligrams, until complete attropinization has occurred. Morphine is contraindicated. Clear chest by postural drainage. Oxygen administration may be necessary. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. Observe patient confundually for 48 hours. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may, without werning, cause prolonged susceptibility to very small dose of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allowing human as determined by blood lest.

STORAGE

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Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal, Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE - If container is damaged. Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled area with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatamaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated abosrbent or to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame.
