STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Take person into fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash thoroughly with plenty of soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get prompt medical attention.
