If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Cont'd.)

Apply spray to dog from a distance of 12 to 14 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the spray over the entire body, including the legs and under portions of the dog. As you spray, fluff the coat so that the spray penetrates to the skin. Spray until the coat is slightly damp. Do not spray in the eyes or face. For best results, spray ticks directly.
