**Statement of Practical Treatment**

**If swallowed**—Call a physician or Poison Control center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. **DO NOT INDUCE** vomiting unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If inhaled**—Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

**If on skin**—Wash immediately with soap and water.

**If in eyes**—Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:**  
**WARNING SYMPTOMS:** Symptoms include weakness, headaches, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pinpoint pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal cramps.  
**TREATMENT:** Atropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation, Atropine Sulfate should be injected at 10 minute intervals, in doses of 1 to 2 mgs, until complete Atropinization has occurred. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with Atropine. Morphine is contra-indicated. Clear chest by postural drainage. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may, without warning, cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor.  
 Allow no further exposure until cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed, as determined by blood test

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For product Prentox Chlorpyrifos DDVP Emulsifiable Concentrate, EPA Registration Number 655-670, change "EPDES" to "NPDES" in the Environmental Hazards text.

For product Prentox Pyrifos DDVP Number 125125 MFG Conc, EPA Registration Number 655-699, delete "Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur" from the Environmental Hazards text since this is not an end use product.
