Statement of Practical Treatment

If swallowed—If a person swallows a quantity of this product which is sufficient to cause symptoms, the person should be taken to a hospital immediately. If inhaled—Remove the person to a well-ventilated area. If symptoms persist, get medical attention.

If in eyes—Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

WARNING SYMPTOMS—Symptoms of acute poisoning may include: nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, dizziness, headache, blurred vision, weakness, and loss of consciousness. In severe cases, respiratory depression and death may occur.

STORAGE
