DIRECTIONS FOR USE
Read the entire Federal Law to use this product in a
manner consistent with its labeling.

This product has been especially developed for use on
horses. It provides a protective hair coating against flies,
imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed.
One ounce per head per day gives adequate
protection. Apply by either soft cloth or fine mist spray.

TO WIPE ON
Brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust.
Do not wet to the point of dripping; a soft
brush rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing
into the hair growth. Give special attention to the
withers, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies
often are seen.

Light application is required. Avoid using an
excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet skin.
After application, brush out thoroughly to bring out
the sheen on the coat.
Reapplication as required.

USE AS A SPRAY
This product may be applied as a fine mist spray to stable
walls, feed troughs and around stabled horses for fast
control of flies. Do not wet horse's skin.
One ounce per head per application.
