DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONT'D.)

Do not use in food areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

PESTS INDOORS: General information. Use as a SPOT TREATMENT to control Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Firebrats, Silverfish, Spiders, and Brown Dog Ticks and around Residential, Industrial, Institutional and Commercial Buildings including homes, apartment buildings, hospitals, stores, manufacturing plants.

COCKROACHES: (including strains resistant to certain other insecticides) ANTS, CRICKETS, FIREBRATS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS FOR SPOT TREATMENT apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush to localized areas where these pests are found or normally occur, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets around plumbing and other utility installations. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Note a period of 4 to 7 days is normally required for maximum effect on cockroaches.

FOR CONTROL OF CARPET BEETLES: Thoroughly apply spray as a spot treatment along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on showing, and where these insects are seen or suspected.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly apply spray as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.**

Prentox^(R) Pyrifos DDVP #525 RTU

Your Application Dated August 20, 1982

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Insert the following phrase immediately under your product name:

Only for Sale to, Use, and Storage by Pest Control Operators.

This addition to the label was discussed with Mr. Miller of your staff on December 27, 1982, via the telephone, and he indicated he had no problem with it as it is primarily a pest control operator product.

We note your request to delete carpet beetles and brown dog ticks from your label and this is acceptable. You failed to mention the dog tick deletion in your amendment application but did delete this claim from your proposed label. In our telephone conversation with Mr. Miller on December 27, 1982, it was determined that the brown dog tick deletion should have been included in the August 20, 1982, amendment application.

Please submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
