

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
WARNING

May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. If swallowed get immediate medical attention. Harmful if inhaled. Do not breathe vapors. Fumes or spray mist causes eye damage. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

1) PROHIBITIONS - Do not contaminate water for drinking, storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open burning is prohibited.

2) PESTICIDE DISPOSAL - Pesticide spray mixture or residue that cannot be used according to label instructions, or disposed of according to Federal, State or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

3) CONTAINER DISPOSAL - Metal: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or disposal, sanitary landfill or by other approved State and local procedures. Household: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and place in trash collection.

NOTE TO APPLICATOR

This product may stain carpeting. Do not allow spray, spray mist, drift or runoff to contact carpeting as staining may occur.


DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONTD.)

Do not use in food areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

PESTS INDOORS: General information: Use as a SPOT TREATMENT to control Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Firebrats, Silverfish, Spiders, and ground. Residential, Industrial, Institutional and Commercial Buildings including homes, apartment buildings, hospitals, stores, manufacturing plants.

COCKROACHES: (Including strains resistant to certain other insecticides) **ANTS, CRICKETS, FIREBRATS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS FOR SPOT TREATMENT** apply as a coarse spray to localized areas where these pests are found or normally occur, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets around plumbing and other utility installations. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Note a period of 4 to 7 days is normally required for maximum effect on cockroaches.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
Open dumping prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: STOP any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. Do not reuse empty container.
