### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**DANGER:** Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin or eyes. Do not get in eyes or on skin or clothing. Do not breathe fumes. Rapidly absorbed through skin. **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is toxic to fish, wildlife and birds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:** Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, state or local procedures.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local procedures.

#### NOTE TO FORMULATORS

Certain organo-phosphate insecticides have been shown to cause staining and color changes of carpets dyed with certain sensitive carpet dyes. Products made from this concentrate should carry warnings to prevent contact with carpeting by spray, spray mist or drift.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**If swallowed** — Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger or give syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If inhaled** — Remove victim to fresh air. Observe for warning symptoms (see side panel). Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Call a physician immediately.

**If on skin** — Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

**If in eyes** — Wash immediately with running water for at least 10 minutes. Call a Physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Active ingredients contain cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with Atropine.



Each of the above products should have the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL text updated or revised at the next label printing to delete references to "burying in a safe place" for both pesticide and container disposal sections. Please refer to the enclosure for approved wording. Also note the inclusion of "disposed of according to Federal or approved state procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act" in the "pesticide Disposal" text.

For product Prentox Chlorpyrifos DDVP Emulsifiable Concentrate, EPA Registration Number 655-670, change "EPDES" to "NPDES" in the Environmental Hazards text.

For product Prentox Pyrifos DDVP Number 125125 MFG Conc, EPA Registration Number 655-699, delete "Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur" from the Environmental Hazards text since this is not an end use product.
