DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONT.)

Use no more than 3.25 ounces of solution per average size room.

Kills Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Hornets, Gnats, Flying Moths and other small Flying Insects, Roaches, Ants, Ticks, Silverfish, Spiders, Centipedes, Millipedes, Fleas, and Bugs.

Vaporizing action of this Spray kills Flies, Mosquitoes and other listed insects in their hiding places, as well as when they are flying. The killing vapors penetrate holes and cracks, spaces behind pictures, curtains and furniture.

To kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Hornets, Gnats, Flying Moths and other small Flying Insects — Close windows and doors. Spray upwards into four corners of room. Rooms filled with fine mist. Leave room closed about 15 minutes. **To kill Wasps and Hornets on nest**, spray nest directly at night. A thorough misting around patio, barbecue picnic tables and other outdoor spaces when air is quiet will repel and kill annoying flying insects. Repeat as necessary.

To kill Roaches, Ants, Ticks, Silverfish, Spiders, Centipedes and Millipedes — Spray cracks of woodwork, walls, floors, around doors, window frames, baseboards, behind shelving of storage areas and other places these insects may congregate, walk or hide. Spray ant trails around doors and window sills. Do not allow children to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry.

DOG KENNELS — **To kill Fleas and Ticks** — Spray animal sleeping quarters fully. Force into cracks in floor and about the room. Wash or replace animal bedding. Repeat as necessary. **Do not spray on animals.**

To kill Bed Bugs — Take bed apart and spray entire surface of bedstead, slats and springs. Spray thoroughly into cracks and joints in bedstead and on tufts and seams of mattress. Do not spray general surface of mattress. Spray on and under baseboards, moldings, cracks in floors and walls and underneath loose wallpaper and other places these insects may be found. Air mattress until completely dry at least 4 hours before re-use.
