DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

1-8 and 16 ounce packages—Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
50 lb. bags: Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.

Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities.

Fleas, Lice And Ticks On Dogs and Cats.
Dust the powder onto the animal's hair and work it down to the skin. After treatment, brush or comb the animal's coat to remove dead fleas and lice. Repeat as needed.

Fleas, Lice and Ticks on Premises
Dust thoroughly all infested areas, particularly crevices in woodwork, floor and floor covering, and animal sleeping quarters. Repeat as needed.
Do not shake dust in eyes. Do not apply to sick animals. Do not use on kittens or puppies less than 4 weeks old.
